Asia now accounts for nearly 7 and 1 2 million people living with HIV. Last year alone, half a million died from AIDS and more than twice as many - 1. 1 million - were infected with HIV. In fact, 1 in 4 new infections worldwide occurred in Asia in 2003, compared to 1 in 5 in 2001. Asia is now home to some of the fastest-growing AIDS epidemics in the world. This is primarily due to sharp increases in HIV infections in China, Indonesia and Viet Nam. In the Pacific, the HIV prevalence rate has reached 1 among women attending antenatal clinics in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea. High levels of sexually transmitted infections, which indicate increased risk for HIV, have also been documented in Samoa and Vanuatu....
